Walk in valleys where towering Huon pines grow for thousands of years, where rivers meet rare temperate rainforest, and snowpeaked mountains shadow buttongrass plains.

This is a place for adventure - test yourself on scores of wild mountain-bike trails, tee off on world-class links perched over Bass Strait, cast for wild brown trout in glacial tarns, or visit one of several wildlife sanctuaries to closer encounter some of our elusive native wildlife.

Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary (A)



Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary is a social enterprise, wildlife rescue base and sanctuary - a very different experience to a zoo. Focusing on the unique wildlife of Tasmania, Bonorong is home to a number of species found nowhere else – some of whom are not able to be released due to injuries, and are required to stay in care. A visit to the sanctuary contributes to the funding of Tasmania's 24-hour rescue service and wildlife hospital. Over the last few years, extra enclosures have been built and upgraded. The wildlife hospital is now open regularly, allowing guests to observe procedures, with improved multi-media installed to share some of the animals' stories of survival. Bonorong's rescue service continues to rescue more animals, year on year.





In Tasmania's south, Tahune Airwalk is an elevated 600m-long walkway above the forest floor. The final cantilevered section sits at a height of 50m above the Huon River, with spectacular views to the confluence of the Huon and Picton Rivers and beyond to the peaks of the breathtaking Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area.

A scenic 80-minute drive south from Hobart, visitors can walk high above the forest and share the lives of forest giants from the spectacular cantilevered platform.

The Airwalk is open seven days a week. Tahune Adventures offers a pristine remote wilderness experience deep in the southwest forest however, the Airwalk, Swinging Bridge and Huon Pine Walks are gentle and easily accessible for all levels of fitness to enjoy.

Additional activities include the Eagle Hang Glider zipline flight across the river for a quick adrenalin rush; or the Twin River Rafting experience, paddling on a raft or kayak through bouncy rapids and quiet stretches of the Picton and Huon Rivers. Visitors can take a break from the forest activities and relax in the cafe and Visitor Centre, with local produce, wine, cider and hot chocolate by the wood fire.


